There's lots to discover in our church. See what you can find.

1. Look at the stained-glass windows and see if you can find the following. Some are harder than others!

- Baby Jesus
- A lamb
- A box of treasure
- Some ears of wheat (see right, top)
- A lady carrying a water pot on her head
- An angel carrying a cup
- A cage with two doves in it
- A brown cow
- An old photograph of Queen Victoria (see right, middle)
- A bowl of fruit
- Three men asleep
- A quiver full of arrows
- Some white lilies (see right, bottom)
- Some tiny window panes showing pictures of the Wise Men's gifts of gold, incense and myrrh



2. Look at the big arch at the front of the church. What are the words written round the edge of the arch?

3. The symbol below is called a **Star of David**. It's a symbol of the Jewish faith from which Christianity came. Can you find three stars of David around the church? The star is made up of two triangles. Can you draw one of your own here?



4. Look at the large table at the front of the church, which is covered in a cloth. It's called an **altar**. What is it used for?



5. Go to the front of church, and look at the stone basin with a wooden cover. It's called a **font**. What do you think it's for? Here's a clue





6. At the front of the church is the **lectern** or 'reading desk', from which the Bible is read out during services. What animal is holding up the Bible on the lectern?

7. Who do you think sits on the large wooden throne at the front of the church?

8. How many organ pipes can you see to the right of the chancel arch? (If you're really clever, you might also want to try to count the organ pipes above the organ itself in the organ chamber!)

9. Look at the 1914–1918 **War Memorial** on the wall near the organ. Sadly, lots of people from Waterhead died in this war. Can you find the name of two officers (Lieutenants) who died in this war?

10. Look at the banner over the main entrance. What is the child giving to Jesus?



Jesus loved children and is often pictured blessing them. Look around the church. Can you find another image of Jesus with a little child?
