- 2. 'O worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness'. It's a quotation from the book of Psalms in the Bible, but is also well-known as the first line of a popular hymn.
- 3. Stars of David: one on the banner over main entrance, one on chancel arch, one on floor in nave by high altar.
- 4. The altar is for celebrating Holy Communion, when we all share bread and wine during church services, in remembrance that Jesus died for us and rose again from the dead.
- 5. The font is filled with water and used for baptisms it's not always a baby who is baptised!
- 6. An eagle traditionally the symbol for St John, who wrote one of the Gospels that tell us about Jesus' life.
- 7. The Bishop
- 8. 25 pipes on the front. There are an amazing 3500 pipes *inside* the organ.
- 9. Lieutenants F. Holden and H. Ashton
- 10. The window shows a child giving flowers to Jesus. The other image of Jesus with a little child is in the big East window, behind the altar.
- 11. It's a memorial book, where the names of people who have died are written down. Every year on the anniversary of their death, the church remembers them in prayer.
