

Answers to questions 2–11

2. **'O worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness'. It's a quotation from the book of Psalms in the Bible, but is also well-known as the first line of a popular hymn.**
3. **Stars of David: one on the banner over main entrance, one on chancel arch, one on floor in nave by high altar.**
4. **The altar is for celebrating Holy Communion, when we all share bread and wine during church services, in remembrance that Jesus died for us and rose again from the dead.**
5. **The font is filled with water and used for baptisms – it's not always a baby who is baptised!**
6. **An eagle – traditionally the symbol for St John, who wrote one of the Gospels that tell us about Jesus' life.**
7. **The Bishop**
8. **25 pipes on the front. There are an amazing 3500 pipes *inside* the organ.**
9. **Lieutenants F. Holden and H. Ashton**
10. **The window shows a child giving flowers to Jesus. The other image of Jesus with a little child is in the big East window, behind the altar.**
11. **It's a memorial book, where the names of people who have died are written down. Every year on the anniversary of their death, the church remembers them in prayer.**
